It may be ordered to help diagnose an ectopic pregnancy, to help diagnose and monitor a pregnancy that may be failing, and/or to monitor a woman after a miscarriage.

Used to detect possible hemolytic newbornn reactions and are a necessary tool to perform blood crossmatches.
BNP (B TYPE NATRIURETIC PEPTIDE) CODE: BNP CPT: 83880	5.0 ml LAVENDER TOP; SPUN AND SEPARATED WITHIN 12 HOURS OF COLLECTION.  SCHEDULE: DAILY	LESS THAN 100 pg/mL	-----	24 hours	9 months	A brain natriuretic peptide (BNP) test measures the amount of the BNP hormone in your blood. BNP is made by your heart and shows how well your heart is working.
BUN (BLOOD UREA NITROGEN) CODE: BUN CPT: 84520	1.0 ml SERUM. FASTING PREFERRED.  SCHEDULE: DAILY	MALE: 6-22 mg/dL FEMALE: 5-20 mg/dL	-----	48 hours	-----	A blood urea nitrogen (BUN) test measures the amount of nitrogen in your blood that comes from the waste product urea.
